How to register: Visit <http://www.naturevision.org/school-programs> to view a program menu. Choose your program(s) and then use the website's registration form to register. Under cost, write "Discuren" for the name of the foundation that is sponsoring the program. Fax the form to 425-868-9849. You will be contacted with a confirmation email or phone call within 2 working days.

Scheduling considerations: Each school may register for 1-20 programs, distributed among all the teachers or only among certain teachers. It's up to you. We are available to visit your school between the hours of 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM. Please allow one hour for each program. Feel free to schedule programs back to back (i.e., 10:00, 11:00, 12:00). A limited number of free programs are available. Pre-registration is required.
